
## Liquid Lime Chemical Feed & Storage System – PAWC New Castle Water Treatment Facility

The Pennsylvania American Water Company (PAWC) operates the 8.4 MGD New Castle Water Treatment Facility that serves 43,600 consumers in the greater New Castle area. GD&F was retained to design a new liquid lime chemical feed and storage system with provisions for enhanced safety to replace a deficient hydrated lime facility.

The project included a chemical building addition housing liquid lime storage tanks and chemical feed equipment. A new bulk liquid lime chemical delivery system and containment structure was constructed next to the new building. A lime feed point was added to the sedimentation basin for enhanced operational flexibility. GD&F also designed filter effluent piping modifications under a separate contract.

GD&F provided all project design, plans, specifications, permit applications, construction administration and inspection services with start-up assistance.
