Sealed Bids for the construction of Well No. 4 Improvements - RE-BID, Contract No. 1: General-Mechanical Work will be received by Montoursville Borough Waterworks at 617 North Loyalsock Avenue, Montoursville, PA 17754 until 10:00 AM local time on July 24, 2026 at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read. The project consists of the replacement of the existing vertical turbine well pump with a submersible turbine pump, well drop piping and control VFD, chemical cleaning of the well and all associated appurtenances.

Copies of the Contract Specifications and Drawings are on file and may be examined at the office of Gwin, Dobson & Foreman, Inc., 3121 Fairway Drive, Altoona, PA 16602-4496 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. daily (prevailing local time) except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays. Sets of such documents may be obtained from the office of Gwin, Dobson & Foreman, Inc. upon payment of Two Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$200.00) payable to Gwin, Dobson & Foreman, Inc., Phone: 814-943-5214; Fax: 814-943-8494. Payment also accepted using VISA and MasterCard. This payment will not be refunded. Contract documents may also be obtained electronically at no charge. Bidding documents including plans, specifications and addenda, must be obtained directly from the Engineer to be considered.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM local time on July 14, 2026 at 617 North Loyalsock Avenue. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory. A site visit will follow the Pre-Bid Conference.

Notice is given that not less than the minimum wage rates set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid to employees on this project in accordance with the Pennsylvania State Prevailing Wage Rates.

The Contractor is subject to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Steel Products Procurement Act of March 3, 1978, P.L. 6, No. 3 Cl. 62, as amended. The Act and amendments require that the Contractor use or furnish only steel products (as defined in the Act and amendments) which have been produced in the United States.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Certified or Bank Check; or Bid Bond naming as payee or obligee (as applicable), the Montoursville Borough Waterworks, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid as security for proper execution of the Agreement and submitting other documents as required by the Bidding Documents. No bids may be withdrawn, except when the Bidder(s) comply with the withdrawal requirements of Act No. 4 of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania, Senate Bill 793, Printers No. 1655, as amended.

The Successful Bidder will be required to execute the Agreement and to furnish a performance and payment bonds, each of said bonds to be in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price, all in the respective forms provided in the Bidding Documents. The Contractor also will be required to furnish evidence of insurance coverage as required by the Bidding Documents. All bonds shall be executed by sureties named in "Circular 570 - Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Sureties in Federal Bonds and as Acceptable Reinsuring Companies" (current publication) by the Audit Staff, Bureau of Government Financial Operations, U.S. Treasury Department.
